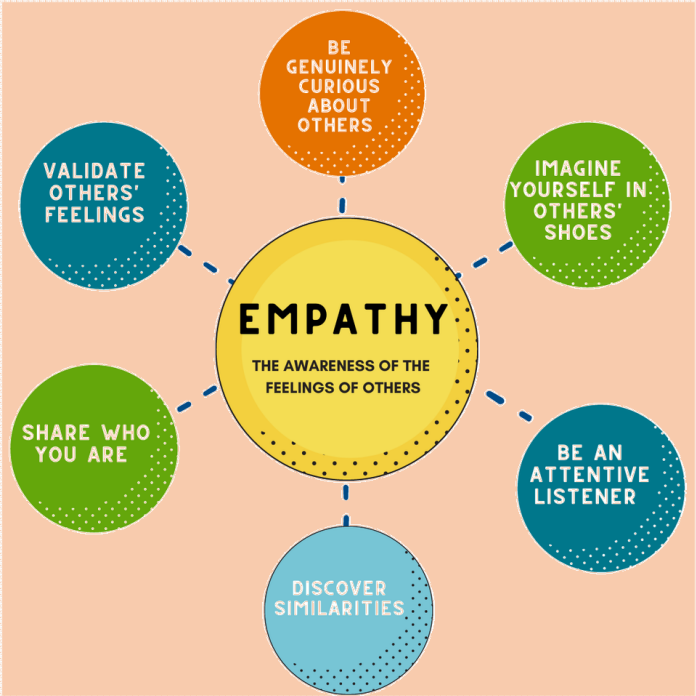

The position is 5 days a week full time approximately 40 hours a week during the months of July and August and part time as needed for the months of June and September (after school and weekends).
