#### Summer Public Works Laborer Position

The Village of Meath Park is currently accepting applications for one (1) summer Public Works General Laborer position. The position is 5 days a week full time approximately 40 hours a week during the months of July and August and part time as needed for the months of June and September (after school and weekends). Employment dates for this position is June 1st, 2024 to September 30th, 2024.

Duties are as follows, but not limited to:

- Clearing/Cleaning sidewalks and ditches; Watering planters;
- Painting;
- Manual Labor;
