## Important Information About the School Bus

Any students needing the school bus this fall must be registered.

It only takes 2 to 3 minutes and is very easy to do!

Registrations do not have to be done every year, but a student must be re-registered if their information (such as school, address or contact info) is changing.

If you are not sure if you already have registered, please give us a call at the number below or simply register again.

Doing so now will ensure your child is placed on the proper bus for the first day of school. Not registering on time could delay having your child assigned a bus several days into the new school year.
