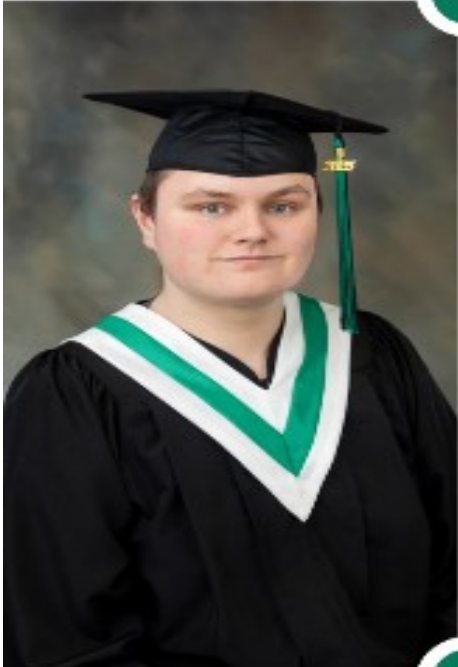
Wishing you a safe, restful, and joy-filled summer. I look forward to reconnecting in the fall as we continue working together to make MP the best school it can be!

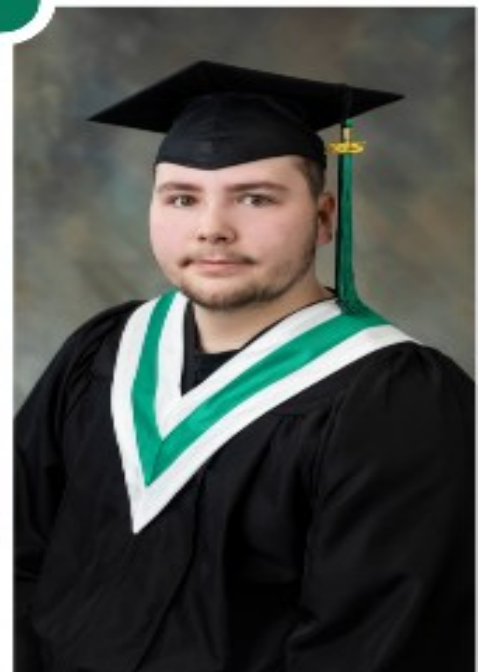
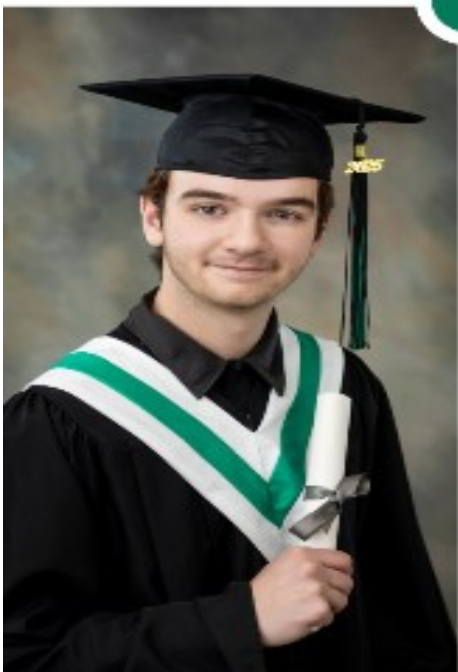

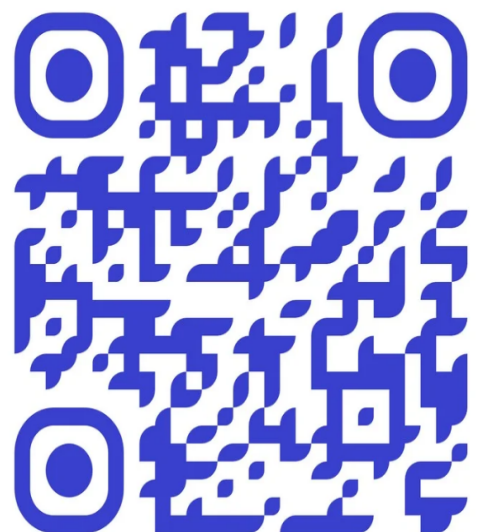
