





Required Qualifications/ Job Description:

- Current CPR C (or obtain within first month of employment)
- Criminal record check with vulnerable sector search
- Facilitate the program school days starting at 7:15am (Snow days included).
- Recruit, hire, train, schedule, and supervise program staff.
- Provide coaching, performance feedback, and professional development opportunities.
- Oversee daily program operations and logistics.
- Manage enrolment, attendance, and parent communication.
- Assist the board with preparing and managing budgets, purchasing, and program resources.
- Ensure accurate record-keeping and reporting.
- Manage invoicing monthly fees and collecting of funds including record keeping.
- Maintain a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment for all children and staff. Build strong relationships with families, school staff, and community partners.
- Address parent concerns professionally and effectively.
- Promote the program and support growth and sustainability.
- Experience in similar child care setting an asset.
- Hourly wage to be discussed / negotiated based on experience.

How to add students to your account

1. Sign in to SchoolCash Online:

2. At the top of the page, navigate to MY ACCOUNT.
3. From the dropdown menu, select My Students.
4. Click to add a student:
 - a. Type in your School Board Name.
 - b. Select your school name from the list.
 - c. Enter student details. The system is fully secure, with PCI certification.
 - d. Click Confirm.

You may add up to eight students on your profile.

How to make a payment

1. You will be able to view any available items attached to your students that are set up on your account.
2. Select the item which you would like to purchase and click "Add to Cart."
3. Once you have finished adding items to your cart, select "Check Out" to make a payment.
