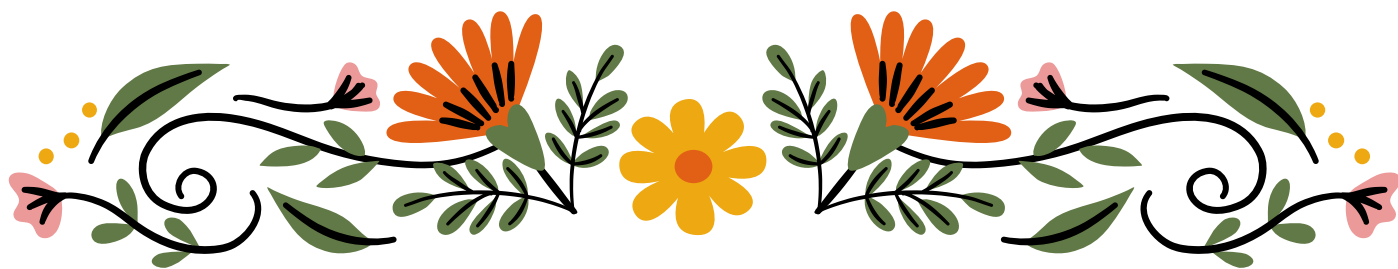

How to add students to your account

1. Sign in to SchoolCash Online: <https://srsd119.schoolcashonline.com>
2. At the top of the page, navigate to MY ACCOUNT.
3. From the dropdown menu, select My Students.
4. Click to add a student:
 - a. Type in your School Board Name.
 - b. Select your school name from the list.
 - c. Enter student details. The system is fully secure, with PCI certification.
 - d. Click Confirm.

You may add up to eight students on your profile.

How to make a payment

1. You will be able to view any available items attached to your students that are set up on your account.
2. Select the item which you would like to purchase and click "Add to Cart."
3. Once you have finished adding items to your cart, select "Check Out" to make a payment.

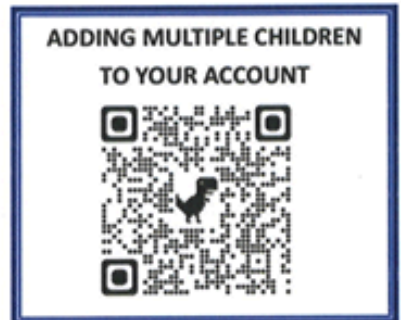
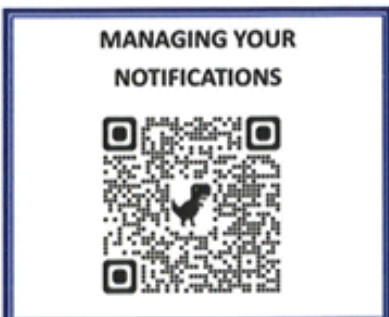

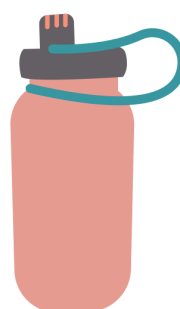
IMPORTANT: Make sure you have accepted the invitation to Edsby that was sent out earlier by email.
